


Arkansas Legislative District Likely Voter Survey January 7-9, 2019


## Methodology

The following survey was conducted by Gilmore Strategy Group within seven legislative districts in Arkansas. Live telephone (55% cell / 45% land) interviews were conducted January 7-9, 2019. This survey consists of 700 likely voters (100 in each legislative district). The margin of error for this survey is ± 3.7%. House Districts included: 2, 4, 52, 60, 81, 99 and 100 2


## When you think about customizing kindergarten through 12th grade education to make it better for our kids, what are the first words that come to mind?




From what you know, which of the following statements most accurately describes parents being able to make the best education decisions for their kids whether that be in a traditional public school, charter, private or home school?





# When considering laws pertaining to education, to whom should your legislator listen to most?


















If you had the opportunity to choose the best educational fit for a child, would you stay at your current school or would you rather customize a child's education?













Do you think a one-size-fits all approach is best to educate students or do you think it is better to allow parents to customize their child's education based on individual needs?










# As you may know, Arkansas schools currently receive over 11,000 dollars per student in funding. knowing that, which of the following comes closest to your opinion?




